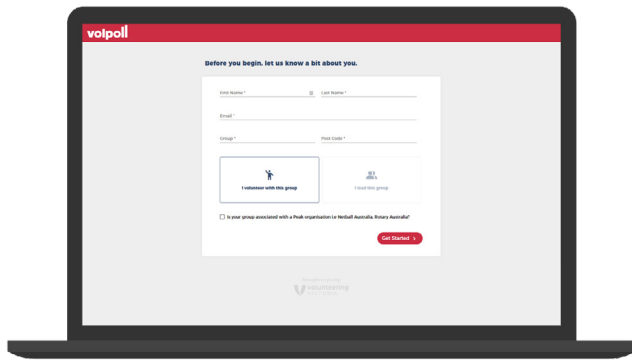

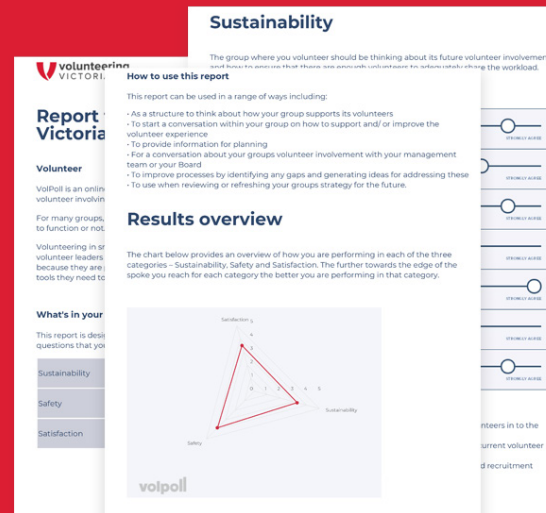
Providing leaders information about your experience can help them make any changes necessary to ensure the organisation's long term success.
